### Here's why we Macon is ... Rich with music history Macon has a rich musical heritage, including big names like Little Richard, Otis Redding and the Allman Brothers Band. The former Capricorn Records studio is now Mercer Music at Capricorn, a recording studio, performance venue and museum. The Cherry Blossom Capital of the World Every year, more than 300,000 Yoshino cherry trees bloom in Macon for a few weeks in the spring, and the city celebrates with its annual International Cherry Blossom Festival. A Great American Main Street Macon-Bibb County independent nonprofit NewTown Macon was one of three organizations nationwide to be honored with the 2024 Great American Main Street Award for its downtown revitalization efforts.
